


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# The Way Of The Buddha: The Illustrated Dhammapada

Please note the size of this book. It is about 4 inches by 6 inches. Of course the verse is wonderful as are the pictures but it is cheap probably because it is so small. It makes it difficult to enjoy the pictures.

I saw this beautiful little book in a chic boutique and fell in love. I quickly searched for it on , and was delighted to find it at a much cheaper price, as usual. I wanted the book mostly for aesthetic

purposes. It is so pretty and a perfect addition to my coffee table as my living room decor has a lot of red and earthy tones with an asian flair. A buyer should be aware of the book's size. It's quite small. Just make sure you read the dimensions before purchasing. I wish it came in a heftier, large coffee table book size.
